The Baker & Taylor Foundation will match gifts from a minimum of \$25 to a maximum aggregate of \$6,000 per fiscal year per eligible donor. The maximum aggregate is based on combining the maximum allowable matches of \$3,000 for educational institutions and \$3,000 for charitable organizations per fiscal year per eligible donor. A matching gift will be based on payment actually completed and not on pledges or commitments for future payments. The matching gift from the Baker & Taylor Foundation is for the unrestricted use of the receiving institution or organization. However, the donor may specify that his or her contribution be used for a designated purpose or project. The donor must indicate this designation on the matching gift application form.

Eligible Donors

Regular full-time associates with at least one year of service, can make contributions at any time during the year and qualify for a matching contribution.

Eligible Institutions and Organizations Matching contributions will **NOT** be made to any institution or organization that restricts membership by race, religion, ethnic background, age, or other limiting factors. In addition, eligible educational institutions and charitable organizations must be:

- Recognized by the United States Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code
- Located in the United States

Eligible educational institutions include:

- Accredited institutions offering a 2-year or 4-year degree, such as universities, colleges, graduate schools, and technical institutions.
- Private elementary and secondary schools
- Alumni associations provided they are certified by the eligible educational institution with which they are affiliated
- Non-athletic scholarship funds provided they are administered by an eligible educational institution

Eligible charitable organizations generally fall into these four categories:

- Cultural including museums and arts councils
- Health & welfare including homeless shelters or hospitals
- Environmental organizations
- Youth groups

Ineligible Gifts

Payments described below will NOT be eligible to receive matching contributions:

- Contributions to organizations or funds established to support athletic programs or athletic scholarships
- Payments that cover tuition, books, student fees, subscriptions, insurance premiums, or tickets, or any payment where the contributor receives any consideration
- Membership fees
- Dues payable to alumni or other groups
- Gifts to fraternities, sororities, or other campus organizations
- Gifts intended to fulfill a person's church-related pledges or other church-related financial commitments

Contributions made jointly by several individuals or on behalf of an ineligible participant.

- Gifts of property, goods or services
- Gifts made for bequests, dues, subscription or membership fees, insurance premiums, tuition payments or payments in lieu of tuition, books, raffles, auctions, tickets to events sponsored by or benefiting an educational institution
- Political action campaigns and election campaigns

In the event of a disagreement regarding eligibility, the Foundation Committee members will make the final determination regarding whether or not a donation will be eligible for a match.

Instructions

- 1. Complete and sign Section A on the second page of this Matching Gift Request Form.
- 2. Send the actual completed and signed form, along with your donation, to a qualifying educational institution or charitable organization.
- 3. The educational institution or charitable organization completes Section B and returns the form to:
